How old is this program?

What is the population of the schools?

Predominantly African-American and Hispanic.

Is there a fee to participate in this program? No one is charged to participate in AAF. Not you (sponsor), not the school, and not the family.

Who funds this program?

This program is funded by our operating funds. How many children receive gifts through this program?

This year, AAF will serve over 400 families and classrooms (1,087 Baltimore City children) through your generosity.

Sponsor Questions

Can we donate from out of town? When you sign up, you can ship the order to our warehouse at 1100 Wicomico St. You will add a gift receipt, with the info for your family ID number.

What's up with the team names? It's fun. Pick a name that makes you chuckle. My favorite is Team Trump (not that Trump). The most popular names have to do with Santa or Elves.

Am I guaranteed a volunteer spot? No, volunteer jobs are extremely limited. Sorry!

Why do you ask for my mailing address and phone number? Families send their sponsor a thank you. This is mandatory.

Should I buy more gifts if I can afford it?

We recommend \$40-60 per child. If you would like to go over, please do. Feel free to add a coat, hat, and glove set.

Can I adopt a family as a group or company?

Yes, you can! Si, se puede. Make sure it is clear in the form when you sign up.

Any chance I can drop the gifts off early?

Yes, you can drop off your gifts early: Sun., Dec. 4th from 2pm to 5pm at our office at 1100 Wicomico St Ste. 330, Baltimore, MD 21230.

I would like to request a Certificate of Gratitude for my team.

Sure, email us after 12/14/2022. We will happily send you your certificate.

Will you add me to your mailing list?

If you want us to.

You didn't respond within 24 hours, why?

Thanks for asking! There is only one staff member for this program due to budget constraints. We (BFA) work on this program and respond 6 days a week from November to mid-December to any and all concerns. Staff from the schools will only respond during normal business hours Monday through Friday. Thanks for understanding that education is an underpaid and important profession. We must protect them at all costs.

Can my company match my donation or sponsor AAF?

Yes, send your HR or executive team an email and let them know that you would like them to match your donation. Some companies will match the hours you spend volunteering, your PTO or your financial contribution. Please ask and help this program continue.

I asked for more families, but I only received 1. What should I do?

Demand a classroom to sponsor! Just kidding. We have classroom requests left. Also, feel free to go above and beyond for the child(ren), caretakers, and school staff. They need love too!

Can I donate cards/gift cards for family members?

Yes, you can!

Can I donate cards/gift cards to school principal/teacher

Of course: Wolfe Street Academy (50 staff and 2 project coordinators), New Song Academy (4 project coordinators), Govans (5 project coordinators), Waverly (1 project coordinator), Margaret Brent (3 project coordinators), and Pimlico (1 project coordinator). BFA has (2 staff members and 4 super volunteers).

Can I donate food for the families or staff?

Is there parking?

Parking is limited at Margaret Brent, Pimlico and Wolfe St. Plan accordinging! Check Google Maps.

Which entrance should I enter?

Check with your coordinator.

How much should I spend for each child? How many gifts should I purchase?

We suggest \$40-60/child. The number of gifts that fit into that dollar amount will vary based on the age of the child and the wish list selections.

What should I buy?

The kids' wish list is a helpful start and along with their favorites-colors, characters, teams-we hope the information provided will make it fun and easy to select something they will enjoy.

Should I wrap my gifts?

No, please bring unwrapped gifts to the appointed drop-off site. Please tag each gift with the family number you were assigned and with the child's assigned number within the family. This is critical! Label/tag every gift with the family ID number and school name. Some people drop off in gift bags with names on each bag, some donors bag their gifts in large black trash bags tied with bows.



No Shows and Missing Gifts

If you fail to show up with your gifts or miss 1 or 2 children, we will have to make those gifts ourselves. Please do not sign up and fail to show. Email us ASAP.

I'd like to buy gifts for the family's parents/caregivers, can I get their information as well?

BFA only collects information on participating children. If you'd like to buy gifts for caregivers we suggest a gift card to a grocery store, Walmart, or Target.

When and where do I drop off my purchased, unwrapped, tagged gifts?

I'm confused about my family wishlist. Can you check please?

Of course. Send an email and we will get back to you as soon as possible.
